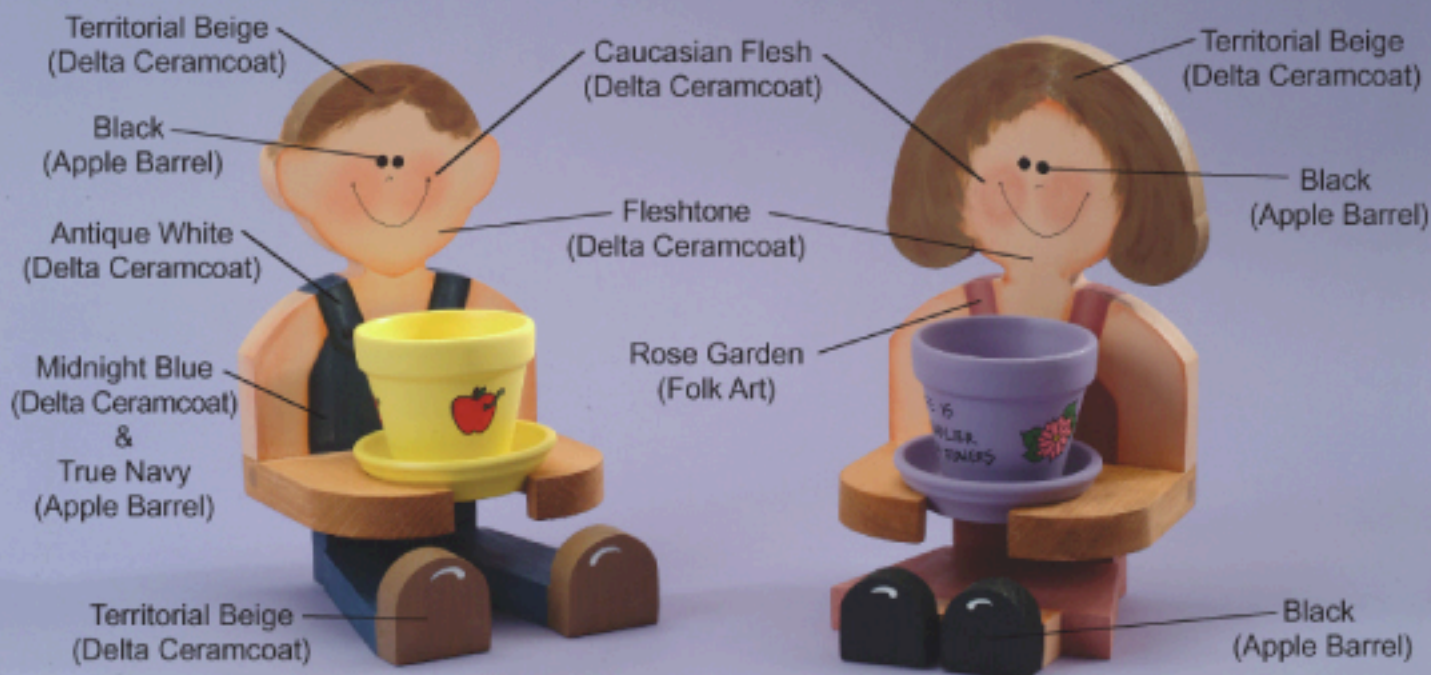
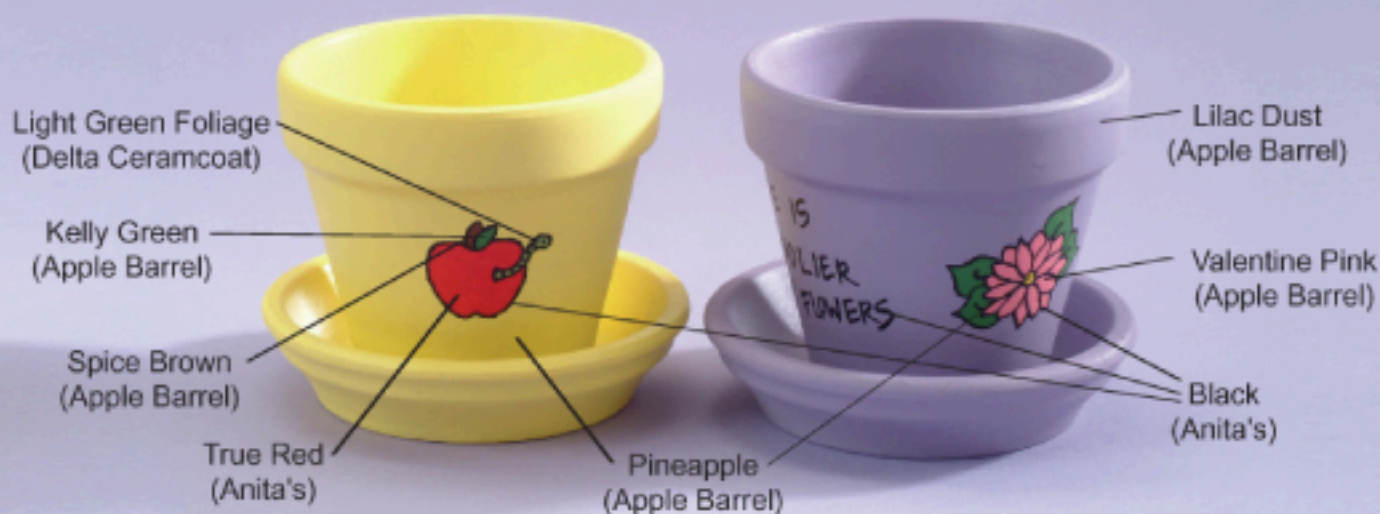

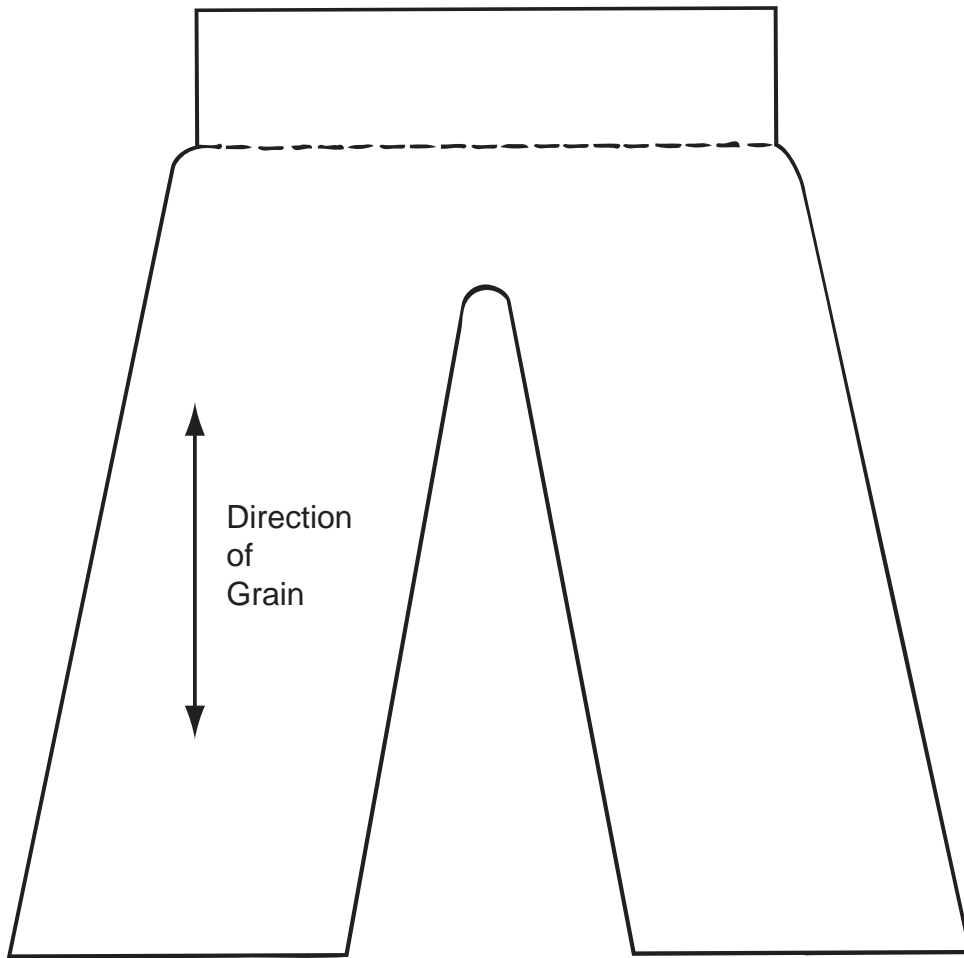
Flowerpot Holders, painted by Kris Johnson

Kris recommends painting the project prior to assembly. She used several brands of acrylic paints. For brushes, she used a #1 liner, a 9150-shader and a stencil brush to dry brush cheeks and overalls. Deft brand Salem Maple #430 stain was also used. As a finish, Kris used a matte finish acrylic sealer.

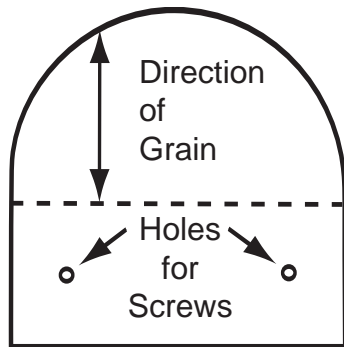


Flowerpots, painted by Rebecca Zieg

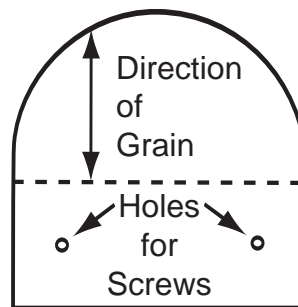
Rebecca suggests painting the entire flowerpot and then lightly tracing the pattern onto the pot with a pencil. She painted the apples and flowers first, then outlined with black paint. She also used a variety of brands of acrylic paints. For brushes, she used Loew-Cornell brand. A 5701 was used for the flower petals, apples, all the outlining and lettering, while a 5608 was used for wash background on both flowerpots. She used Crafts Etcetera clear acrylic gloss coating for the finish.



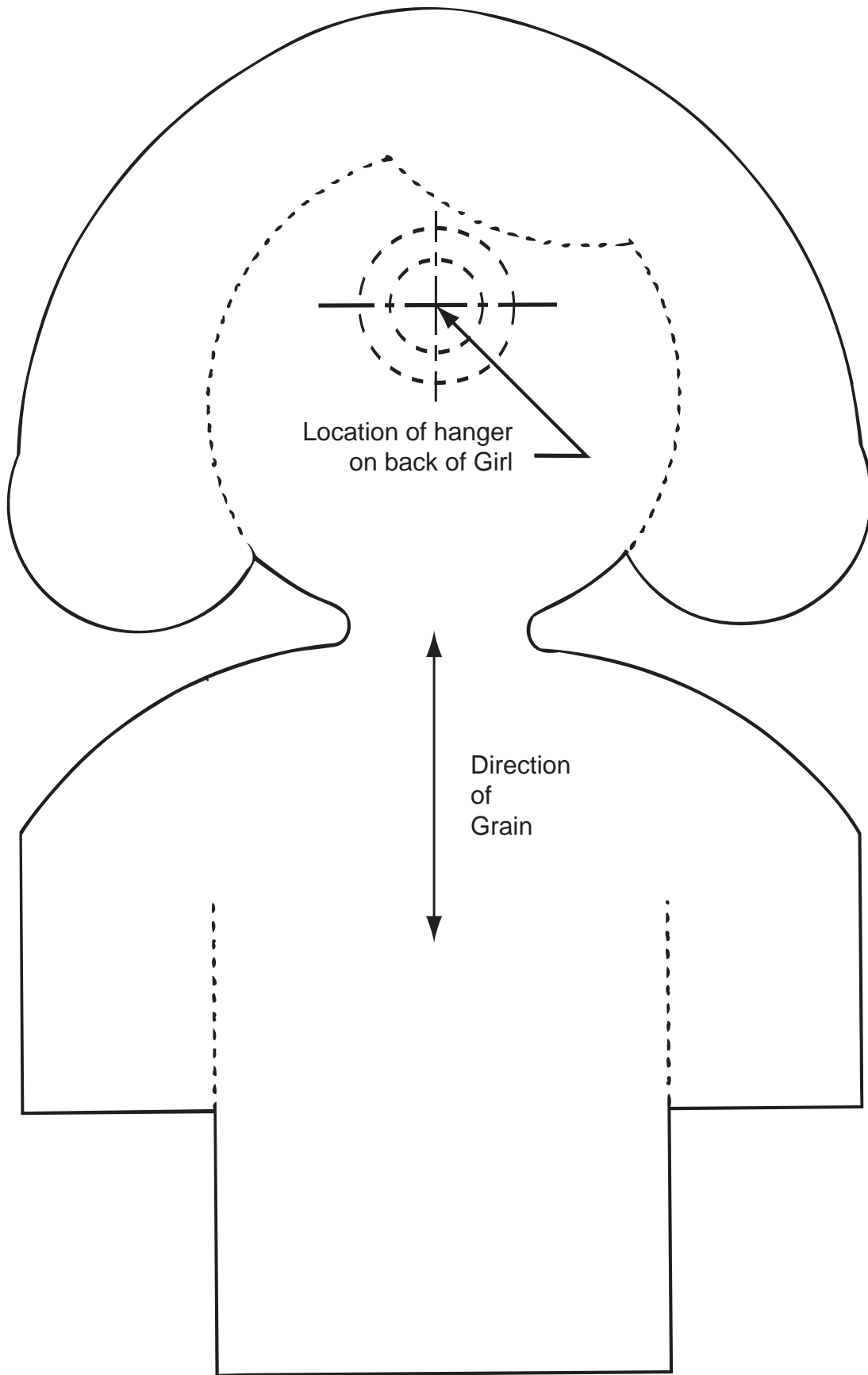
Legs of Boy

(2 Required)



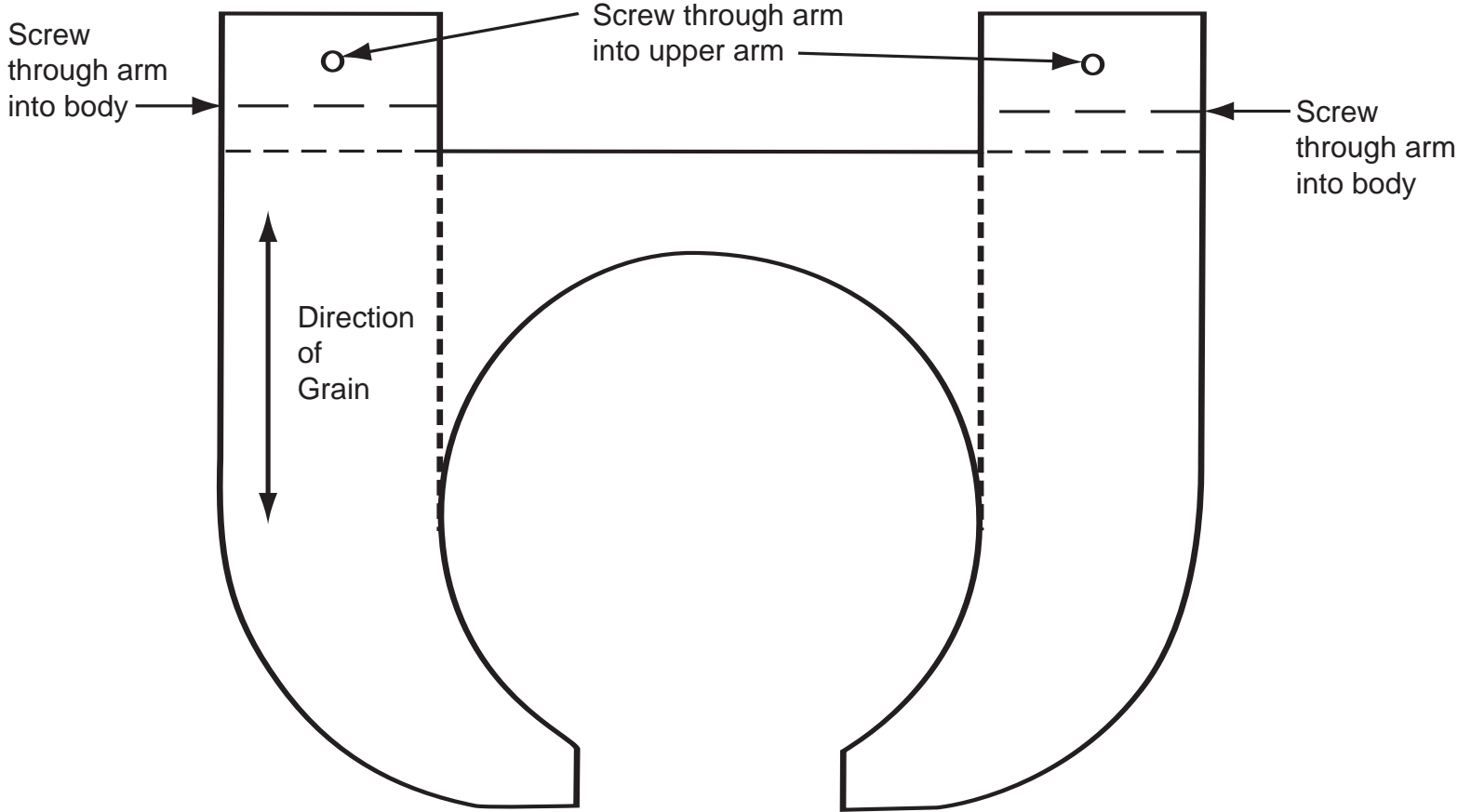
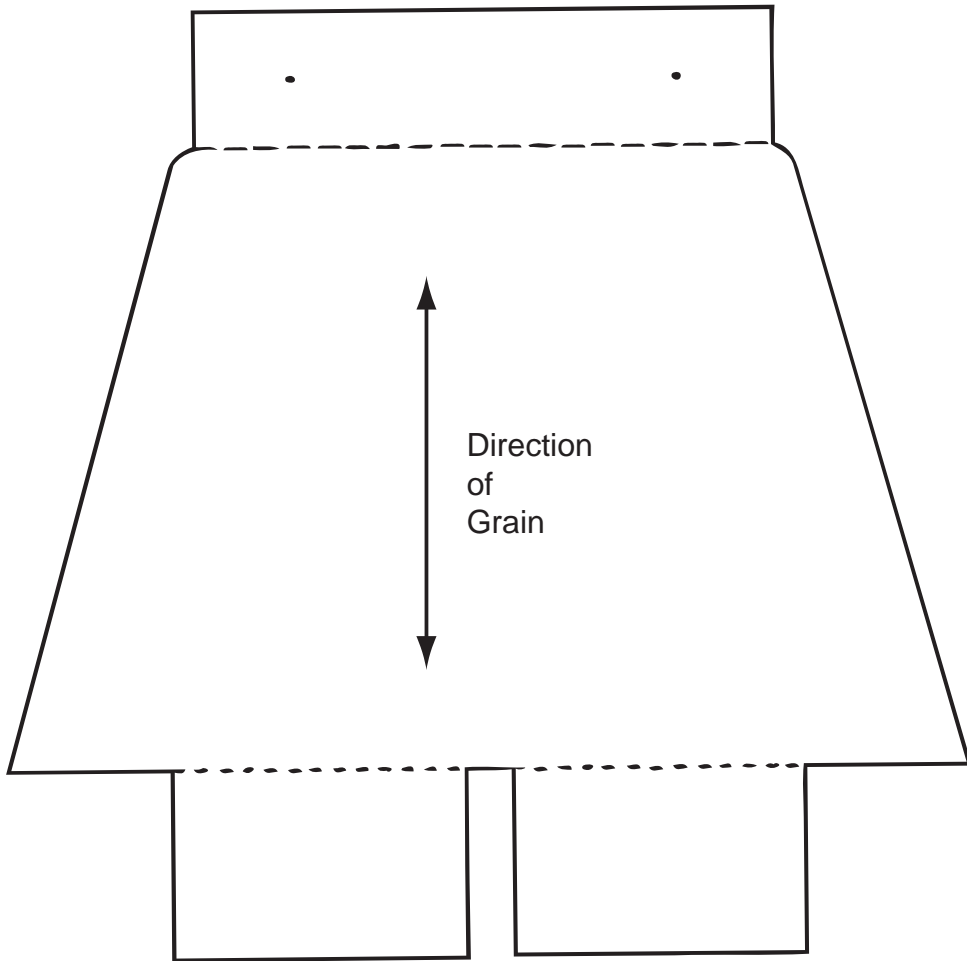
Girl's Shoe
