### Materials:

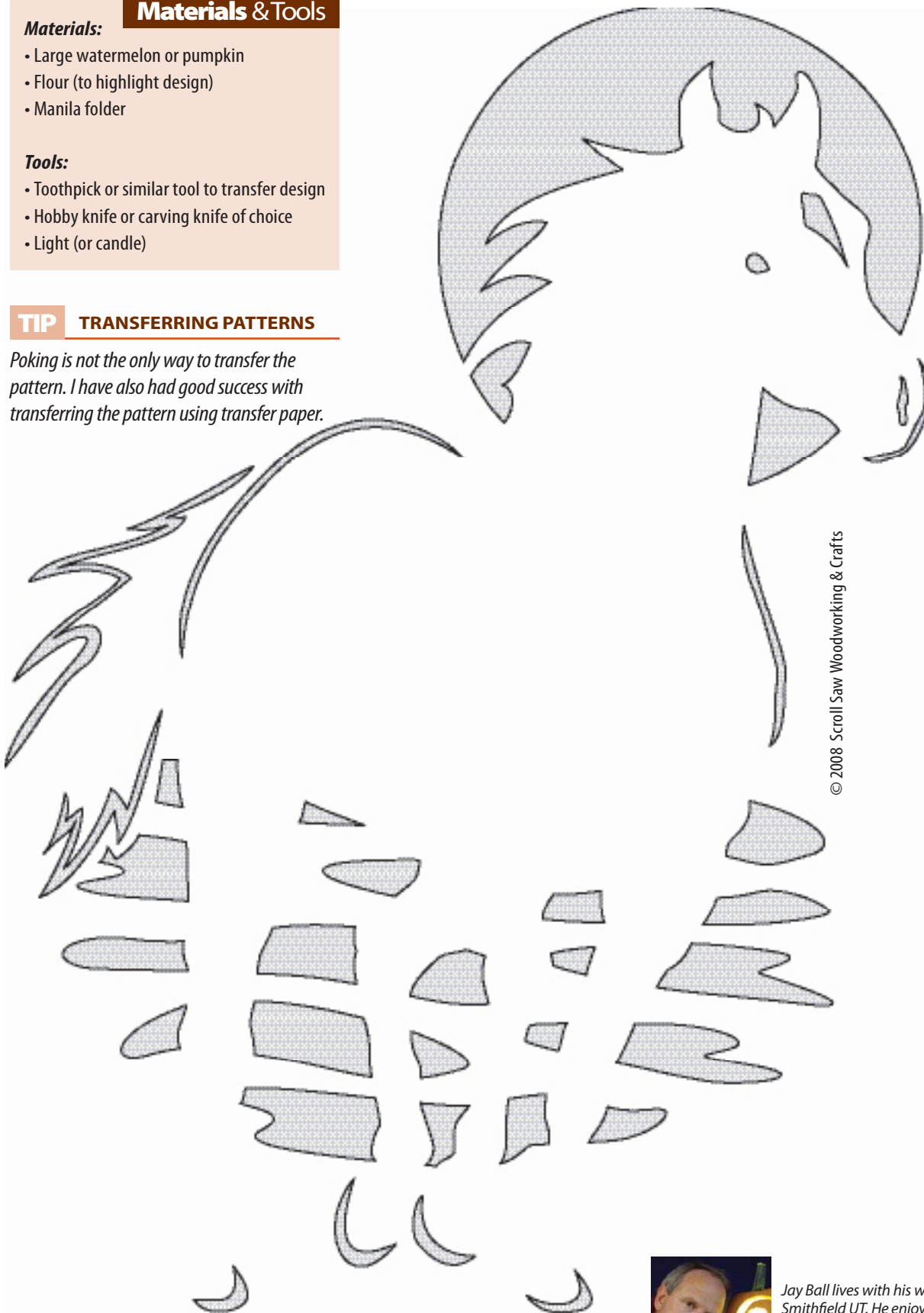
- Large watermelon or pumpkin
