

Sunflower Puzzle Box Pendant

Painting Guide



Watering can and tools: Base-coat with silver anniversary (5), and paint the handles deep burgundy (2).



Flowerpot: Base-coat with cadmium orange (2), shade with burnt sienna (3), and add a dot of burnt sienna (3) for the hole in the bottom.

Cardinal: Base-coat with holiday red (4), use black (2) for the face, use a stylus to dot the eye with white (5) and then black (2). Use honey brown (2) for the beak and legs. Draw the wings using a liner brush and thinned black (2).



Worms: Base-coat with deep burgundy (2).



Garden snake: Base-coat with medium Hauser green (2), add a white (5) eye dot and then a black (2) eye dot.



Bee: Base-coat with bright yellow (1), paint the head and lines black (2), use white pearl (3) to add wings.

Snail: Base-coat with buttermilk (3), paint body with honey brown (2). Use liner brush with honey brown (2) to add the shell details.



Bunny: Base-coat with honey brown (2). Add the details with a liner brush and thinned black (2).

Butterfly: Base-coat with black (2) and add cadmium orange (2) wings. Add the details with a liner brush and thinned black (2).



TIP

HOLDING SMALL PIECES

Use tweezers or hemostat clamps to hold the smaller pieces while you paint.



Seed packet: Base-coat with white (5), write "Seeds" on one side in pencil, and make a flower with five dots of cadmium orange (2) with a yellow (1) dot for the center on the other side.



Ladybugs: Base-coat with holiday red (4) and add black (2) heads. Add the dots on the body with black (2) paint and a stylus or toothpick.
